

## GAME 3 – Elimination Game – San Joaquin Delta 5, Santa Ana 1

FRESNO – The San Joaquin Delta College Mustangs remained in the hunt for a state title, thanks to a 5-1 win over the Santa Ana College Dons on Sunday at the 2009 CCCAA State Baseball Championships, played at Fresno City College's John Eules Ballpark.

With the win, the Mustangs will take on the loser of today's matchup between Diablo Valley and Orange Coast tonight at 6 p.m.

The loss ends the Dons' season at 37-13.

Delta (33-18) was led by the all-around play of Jared Schlehuber. The freshman righty threw 7 1/3 innings, allowing no runs on five hits, walking two and striking out three to improve to 7-1. At the plate, Schlehuber was his own best friend, going 2-for-5, including a two-run home run that put the Mustangs up 3-0 in the third inning.

Santa Ana started Daniel Fenwick (0-1) and the sophomore righty did not finish the fourth inning, allowing three runs on seven hits.

Lefty reliever Chris Anklam worked out of jams in the eighth and ninth innings to pick up the save, his second of the season.

Aaron Rowley went 3-for-3 with a run and an RBI, while Evan Peters added a couple of hits for the Mustangs.

For Santa Ana, Marcus Piazzisi, Christopher Miller and Derek Eligio each had two hits, but the Dons struggled to score runs all weekend and were held to just three runs in the state tournament.
